- 1. Property affected: 2913 Broadmore St., 39S09E03CC, tax lot 700 in Klamath Falls, Klamath County, Oregon. Legal description of area of deed notice is included as Exhibit A. The property is zoned for heavy industrial use and is currently occupied by a trucking company.
- 2. Historic releases of solvents (trichloroethene and associated breakdown products, cis-1,2-dichloroethene, trans-1,2-dichloroethene and vinyl chloride) from the Chemtura Asphalt Plant located at 2936 Hilyard Ave., Klamath Falls have impacted groundwater. Multiple phases of on- and off-site investigations and remedial actions have been performed to delineate and address the extent of the solvent contamination discovered in 1995. Shallow groundwater contamination has migrated on the southwestern corner of the property. Groundwater concentrations, exceeding generic risk-based concentrations for the ingestion & inhalation from tapwater pathways pathway as listed in DEQ's "Risk-Based Decision Making for the Remediation of Petroleum-Contaminated Sites" guidance dated September 22, 2003 and subsequent updates, are present.
- 3. The purpose of this deed notice is to provide notice that solvent contamination is present in the southwestern corner of the property. 269.65 feet to the true point of beginning.

SAVING AND EXCEPTING unto the Great Northern Railway Co., a Minnesota corporation, its successors and assigns, the right to maintain and use the present railway tracks upon, over and across the above described property.

ALSO EXCEPTING THEREFROM a reservation unto the Great Northern Railway Co., a Minnesota corporation, its successors and assigns forever, all iron, natural gas, coal, oil and all minerals of any nature whatsoever upon or in the lands above described together with the sole, exclusive and perpetual right to explore for, remove and dispose of the same by means or methods suitable to the Grantor, its successors and assigns, but without entering upon or using the surface of the lands above described, and in such manner as not to interfere with the use thereof by the Grantee, its successors and assigns.
