The buyer agrees that at all times buyer will keep the premises and the buildings, now or hereafter erected thereon, in good condition and repair and will not suffer or permit any waste or strip thereof; that buyer will keep the premises free from construction and all other liens and save the seller harmless therefrom and reimburse seller for all costs and attorney fees incurred by seller in defending against any such liens; that buyer will pay all taxes hereafter levied against the property, as well as all water rents, public charges and municipal liens which hereafter lawfully may be imposed upon the premises, all promptly before the same or any part thereof become past due; that at buyer's expense, buyer will insure and keep insured all buildings now or hereafter erected on the premises against loss or damage by fire (with extended coverage) in an amount not less than \$\frac{1}{2}\$.
