THIS INDENTURE, Made this 4/22/2014, by and between Frank Skrah, Sheriff of Klamath County, Oregon, hereinafter called the grantor, and HSBC Bank USA, N.A., as indenture trustee for the registered noteholders of Renaissance Home Equity Loan Trust, 2006-4, in c/o Ocwen Loan Servicing, LLC, 12650 Ingenuity Drive. Orlando, FL 32826, hereinafter called the grantee; WITNESSETH:

RECITALS: In a suit in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, Court Case Number 1300001CV, Klamath County Sheriff's Office Number J13-0056, in which HSBC Bank USA, National Association, as indenture trustee for the registered noteholders of Renaissance Home Equity Loan Trust 2006-4 was plaintiff(s) and Miguel H. Cobian; Ramona Pena; Persons or Parties Unknown Claiming any Right, Title, Lien or Interest in the Property Described in the Complaint Herein was defendant(s), in which a Writ of Execution in Foreclosure, which was issued on 5/17/2013, directing the sale of that real property, pursuant to which, on 8/23/2013 the real property was sold, subject to redemption, in the manner provided by law, for the sum of \$54,000.00, to HSBC Bank USA, N.A., as indenture trustee for the registered noteholders of Renaissance Home Equity Loan Trust, 2006-4, who was the highest and best bidder, that sum being the highest and best sum bid therefore. At the time of the sale, the purchaser paid the amount bid for the property to the grantor or grantor's predecessor in office. After Grantor received funds in the amount bid at the sale, a certificate of sale, as required by law, was duly executed and delivered to the purchaser.

The real property has not been redeemed from the sale, and the time for so doing has now expired. The grantee herein is the owner and holder of the Certificate of Sale and has delivered the certificate to grantor.



NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of said Writ of Execution, and in consideration of the sum paid for the real property at the sale, the grantor has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the grantee, grantee's heirs, successors, and assigns, that certain real property situated in Klamath County, Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Parcel 1:

A portion of Lot 8, Block 89, Buena Vista Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, according to the official plat thereof on file in the office of the County Clerk of Klamath County, Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Lot 8 and running thence Northeasterly along the Southerly line of Delta (formerly Yolo) Street to the corner common to Lots 8 and 9 of said Block 89; thence Southeasterly along the line common to said Lots 8 and 9, 104.4 feet to a point; thence at right angles to said line Southwesterly 50 feet to a point on the Westerly line of said Lot 8; thence Northwesterly along said Westerly line of said Lot 8 a distance of 98 feet to the point of beginning.

Parcel 2:

The Southerly 50 feet of Lot 8 in Block 89 of Buena Vista Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, according to the official plat thereof on file in the office of the County Clerk of Klamath County, Oregon.

Together with all of the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and all of the interest of the defendant(s) (and each of them) in and to the real property;

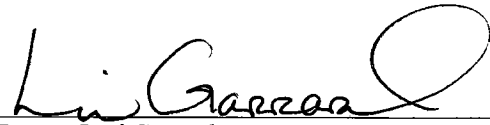

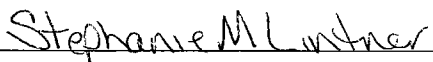
