TRUSTEE'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Dated November 24, 2014, between **NATHAN J. RATLIFF**, hereinafter called "trustee," and **TAMMY LEE ZANINOVICH**, hereinafter called the "second party": WITNESSETH:

RECITALS:

GEORGE McCOY, as grantor, executed and delivered to NATHAN J. RATLIFF, as trustee, for the benefit of TAMMY LEE ZANINOVICH, assignee of THE ESTATE OF JUNIOR LEE JACKSON, as beneficiary, a certain trust deed dated November 6, 2013, recorded on November 15, 2013, in the Records of Klamath County, Oregon, as Instrument No. 2013-012776.
