
SEE ABOVE REFERENCED TRUST DEED

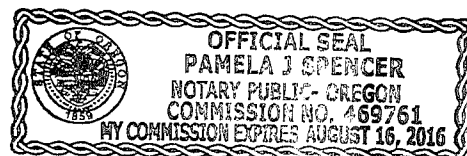
