TRUSTEE'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Dated July 13, 2016, between Robinson Tait, P.S., hereinafter called trustee, and Wells Fargo Bank, National Association, as Trustee for Option One Woodbridge Loan Trust 2003-1, Asset Backed Certificates, Series 2003-1, hereinafter called second party; WITNESSETH: RECITALS: ROSS PAUL ANELLO AND RITA J. ANELLO, HUSBAND AND WIFE, AS TENANTS BY THE ENTIRETY as grantor, executed and delivered to Aspen Title & Escrow, Inc., as trustee, for the benefit of Chapel Mortgage Corporation, as beneficiary, a certain trust deed dated May 21, 2002, recorded on May 28, 2002, in the Records of Klamath County, Oregon as instrument number M02, page 31109. In that trust deed, the real property therein and hereinafter described was conveyed by the grantor to the trustee to secure, among other things, the performance of certain obligations of the grantor to the beneficiary. The grantor thereafter defaulted in performance of the obligations secured by the trust deed as stated in the notice of default hereinafter mentioned, and such default still existed at the time of the sale hereinafter described.

By reason of the default, the owner and holder of the obligations secured by the trust deed, being the beneficiary therein named, or the beneficiary's successor in interest, declared all sums so secured immediately due and owning. A notice of default containing an election to sell the real property and to foreclose the trust deed by advertisement and sale to satisfy the asserting grantor's obligations was recorded on February 29, 2016, in the Records of Klamath County, as instrument number 2016-002196, to which reference is now made.

The true and actual consideration for this conveyance is \$29,500.00.

After recording the notice of default, the undersigned trustee gave notice of the time for and place of sale of the real property, as fixed by the trustee and as required by law. Copies of the notice of sale were served pursuant to ORCP 7 D (2) and 7 D (3), or mailed by both first class and certified mail with return receipt requested, to the last known addresses of the person or their legal representatives, if any, named in ORS 86.740 (1) and 86.740 (2)(a), at least 120 days before the date the property was sold. A copy of the notice of sale was mailed by first class and certified mail with return receipt requested to the last known address of the fiduciary or personal representative of any person named in ORS 86.740 (1), promptly after the trustee received knowledge of the disability, insanity or death of any such person. Copies of the notice of sale were served in accordance with ORS 86.750 (1) upon occupants of the property described in the trust deed at least 120 days before the date the property was sold. If the foreclosure proceedings were stayed and released from the stay, copies of an amended notice of sale in the form required by ORS 86.755 (6) were mailed by registered or certified mail to the last known addresses of those persons listed in ORS 86.764 and 86.7450 (1) and to the address

provided by each person who was present at the time and place set for the sale which was stayed within 30 days after the release from the stay. The trustee published a copy of the notice of sale in a newspaper of general circulation in each county in which the real property is situated once a week for four consecutive weeks. The last publication of the notice occurred more than twenty days prior to the date of sale. The mailing, service and publication of the notice of sale are shown by affidavits and/or proofs of service duly recorded prior to the date of sale in the county records, those affidavits and proofs, together with the Notice of Default and Election to Sell and the notice of sale, being now referred to and incorporated in and made a part of this deed as if fully set forth herein. The undersigned trustee has no actual notice of any person, other than the persons named in those affidavits and proofs as having or claiming a lien on or interest in the real property, entitled to notice pursuant to ORS 86.740 (1)(b) or (1)(c).

The undersigned trustee, on July 12, 2016, at 10:00 AM in accord with the standard of time established by ORS 187.110 and at the place so fixed for sale, in full accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon and pursuant to the powers conferred upon the trustee by the trust deed, sold the real property in one parcel at public auction to the second party for the sum of \$29,500.00, the second party being the highest and best bidder at the sale, and that sum being the highest and best bid for the property.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of that sum so paid by the second party in cash, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and by the authority vested in the trustee by the laws of the State of Oregon and by the trust deed, the trustee does hereby convey unto the second party all interest in which the grantor had or had the power to convey at the time of grantor's execution of the trustee deed, together with any interest the grantor or grantor's successors in interest acquired after the execution of the trust deed in and to the following described real property:
