CONSTRUCTION STIPULATIONS AGREEMENT

For valuable consideration, Rodney R. Lyon and Marie M. Lyon, husband and wife ("Grantor") whose address is 20302 Paygr Rd, Malin, OR 97632, does grant to WILLIAMS PACIFIC CONNECTOR GAS OPERATOR, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, on behalf of Pacific Connector Gas Pipeline, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership, located at P.O. Box 58900, Salt Lake City, Utah 84158 ("Grantee"), its agents, contractors and employees, the right and privilege of using a parcel of land for the purpose of constructing a 36" Natural Gas Pipeline ("construction workspace"), which property is situated in Klamath County, State of Oregon, and more particularly described below:

That certain parcel, or parcels, of land lying in Sections 34,35 and 36, Township 40 South, Range 12 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, and

That certain parcel, or parcels, of land lying in Sections 3 and 2, Township 41 South, Range 12 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, being more fully described in the attached Exhibits"A-1"

The approximate location of the construction workspace is designated on Exhibits "A" attached hereto and made a part of this agreement.

It is understood and agreed by Grantor and Grantee that said construction workspace is to be used in connection with the construction of Grantee's natural gas pipeline facilities. Upon completion of the above described work and final restoration of the construction workspace, Grantee's interest in said land will revert to Grantor, except as provided by the right-of-way and easement dated August 21,2010

Grantee agrees that within a reasonable time following the completion of its work and subject to weather and/or soil conditions, Grantee will as near as practicable restore said construction workspace to its original contours. Grantee will compensate Grantor for adequately documented damages, directly resulting from its work including timber, growing crops, pasture and livestock. Damages to other real or personal property will be repaired by Grantee or the Grantor will be compensated for such repairs. Specific conditions, which will apply only to the initial construction of facilities, are described in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and made a part of this agreement.

The term of this construction stipulation agreement begins upon execution and expires five years from that date.

Grantee will possess the above-described rights and such rights will be binding upon Grantor, its heirs, legal representatives and successors in title.

Grantee will not be held liable for damages of any kind that arise due to the negligent acts or willful misconduct of the Grantor, its successors, assigns, permittee, agents or contractors.





























EXHIBIT "A-1"

EXHIBIT "B"

CONSTRUCTION STIPULATIONS

In accordance with the terms and conditions of this agreement, the Grantor and Grantee agree that the natural gas pipeline facilities will be constructed on Grantor's property in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Grantee will notify Grantor, in writing, of the construction activity 10 days prior to start of survey and via phone or in writing, at least 30 days prior to the clearing/tree removal and construction preparation of the right of way on the Grantor's land.
- 2. Grantee will construct its pipeline and related facilities in compliance with engineering design and safety standards of the USDOT in force at the time of construction.
- 3. Grantee will remove all construction waste and debris after completion of construction activities.
- 4. Grantee will restore all access roads or driveways disturbed by construction to condition equal to or better than existed prior to construction. Restoration will include final grading where necessary.
- 5. Grantee will be responsible for the control of noxious weeds on land disturbed by reasonable necessary construction activities.
- 6. Grantee will remove all rock 4" or greater from the disturbed areas.
- 7. Grantee will install two buried road crossing located at Grantor's existing sand pit. This location is shown on Exhibit "A" KH-835.080 and KH-848.026 is made a part of this Construction Stipulation Agreement. Grantor and Grantee agree that weight limitations of all vehicles operating within, over, or across Grantee's easement at said identified buried pipeline road crossing and areas with pipe located within the roadway, shall comply with the axle and gross vehicle weight combinations described in Chapter 818, Oregon Department of Transportation.

Application for loads to be operated within, over, or across Grantee's easement at identified pipeline road crossings and areas with pipe located within the roadway that exceed the gross vehicle weight combinations described in Oregon Department of Transportation Chapter 818 will be submitted for review and approval through Grantee's local Operating District at least twenty (20) days in advance of need.

- 8.. In the event the Grantee fails to initiate construction activities within the Right-of-Way and Easement within a period of fifteen (15) years from the execution date thereof, the Grantor will seek and obtain a reconveyance.
- 9. Grantee has paid Grantor for Landscaping Damages (Timber) in full. Grantor is not in the Oregon Small Tract Forest (STM) Program.
