14 183.480. You may request judicial review by filing a petition with the Court of Appeals in Salem,
15 Oregon within 60 days from the date of service of this Final Order. Appeal of this Final Order does
not stay any of the compliance requirements set forth in the Order section of this Final Order unless
you request and the Department issues a stay.

16 **Notice regarding payment of the civil penalty:** If the civil penalty remains unpaid for more than
17 10 days from the date the civil penalty becomes due, the civil penalty will be recorded and filed
18 with county clerks as liens against any property owned by you. The civil penalty becomes due
19 either at the end of the statutory appeal period (60 days) or if appealed, when an order is issued by
20 the Court of Appeals.
