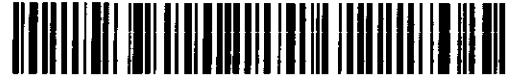

KNOW ALL BY THESE PRESENTS that Klamath County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon hereinafter called grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated, does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto **Krebs Realty LLC**, hereinafter called grantee, and unto grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, all of the grantor's right, title and interest in that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any way appertaining, situated in Klamath County, State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Subject to covenants, conditions, restrictions, easements, reservations, rights, rights of way and all matters appearing of record.

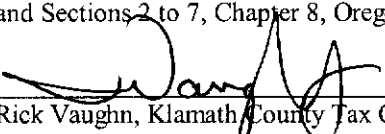
To Have and to Hold the same unto grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns forever.

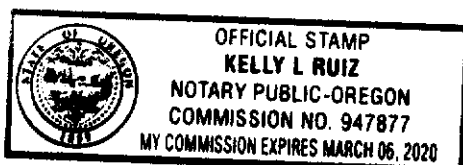

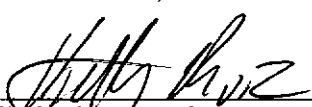
