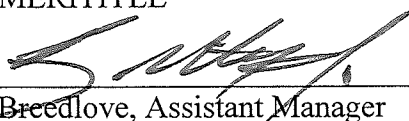
Having received from the Beneficiary under said Trust Deed a written request to reconvey,

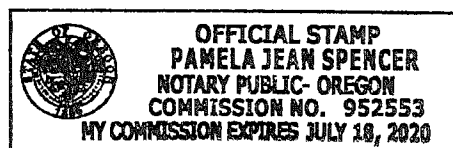

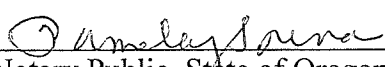
