In support of the authority of Assemblies of God, Oregon District, as successor in interest to Malin Assembly of God, to sell and transfer real property in the name of Malin Assembly of God, to Assemblies of God, Oregon District, comes now Assemblies of God, Oregon District, by and through Lee McCloud, its Vice President, and Boyd S. Powers, its Secretary, each being first duly sworn on oath, depose and say:

- 1. Attached hereto as Exhibit A-1 and hereby incorporated herein by reference is a true and correct copy of the current effective Articles of Incorporation of Malin Assembly of God signed on September 12, 1954 by officers of the church and witnessed by Atwood Foster, the then acting superintendent and president of Assemblies of God, Oregon District. Said Articles of incorporation provide, among other things, as follows:
- a. Article II, Section 4, "To function as a local Assembly of God in harmony with the Constitution and By-laws of the Oregon District Council and of the General Council of the Assemblies of God."
- b. Article IV provides that: "In the event this Assembly shall at any time cease to function as a religious body to fulfill its object, business and purpose as herein stated all rights to its property, money and interests shall become the property of the Assemblies of God, Oregon District."
- c. Article V, Section 4 provides that: "The Pastor shall be a member in good standing with the General and/or the Oregon District Council of the Assemblies of God and shall comply with the scriptural and Assembly of God standards for the ministry."

- 2. Malin Assembly of God has ceased to function as a local Assembly of God in harmony with the Constitution and Bylaws of the Oregon District Council, as provided for in the Articles of Incorporation, Article II, Section 4.
- 3. Malin Assembly of God has ceased to function as a religious body to fulfill its object, business and purpose as stated in the aforementioned Articles, Article IV.
- 4. There is no existing pastor of the church in good standing with the General Council and/or the Oregon District Council of the Assemblies of God as required in the aforementioned Articles, Article V, Section 4.
- 5. The facts outlined above give authority of the Assemblies of God, Oregon District, as successor in interest to Malin Assembly of God, to transfer the property of Malin Assembly of God to the Assemblies of God, Oregon District, as provided in the governing instruments of Malin Assembly of God, as set forth above.
