5. Finally, once the problem is solved, you should document the solution so that it can be used in the future.

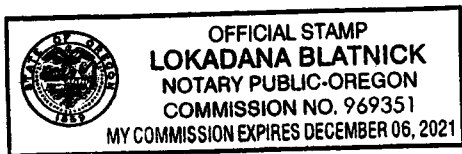
