## EXHIBIT 'A' LEGAL DESCRIPTION

A portion of the \$1/2 \$W1/4 NW1/4 in Section 11, Township 39 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, being more particularly described as follows:
