REVOCABLE LICENSE & ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

The City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, a municipal corporation (City) and Kevin Leon Kemp and Molly Suzanne Gonzales Kemp (Grantees) for and in consideration of the covenants and conditions hereinafter set forth, agree as follows:

City hereby gives and grants to Grantees, its successors and assigns, upon the terms and subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, revocable, non-exclusive permission to encroach upon the right of way off Tiffany Street and Van Ness Street, in the City of Klamath Falls located near the property commonly known as 1717 Tiffany Street, legally described as lots 13, 14 and 15 in Block 37 of Mountain View Addition (R-3809-020DD-02800-000) (as shown on the attached map Exhibit "A," and referred to herein as the "Area"). This license/permit is granted for the limited purpose of increased visibility and landscaping. This license/permit is subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Grantees shall comply with all relevant local, state and federal regulations pertaining to Grantees' use of the Area, including but not limited to, City Planning and building regulations;
- 2) Grantees shall submit the as-built construction plans to the City's Public Works Department and shall conform to any modifications or restrictions imposed by the Department; and
- 3) Grantees shall be responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the Area, for all expenses for removal of the Area improvements if required under this license/permit, and for restoration of the right-of-way damaged by maintenance, upkeep or removal.

Grantees agree to pay to the City, as compensation for the privileges herein granted, the sum of (\$92.00) for cost of recording/permit fee, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by City.

Grantees shall save and hold harmless the City from, and indemnify the City against, any and all liability for or on account of any death or injury to persons, or damage to property incurred in any manner whatsoever growing out of Grantees' use or the public's loss of the privileges herein granted.

This Agreement shall run from year to year unless terminated. It may be terminated upon sixty (60) days written notice by either party. Upon termination, Grantees shall remove all structures and improvements herein authorized and restore the unimproved public right-of-way in accordance with the directions of the City's Director

of Public Works within sixty (60) days. Grantees agree that City shall not be responsible for damage to any structures or improvements within the right-of-way caused by or related to City's legitimate use of the right-of-way.
