# EXHIBIT'A' VANDENBERG RD

A strip of land for road right of way and public utility purposes being a portion of that parcel described in Klamath County Deed Volume 330 Page 53 recorded May 29<sup>th</sup> 1961 situate in the West ½ of Section 34, Township 38 South, Range 9 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County Oregon; said strip being variable in width, the centerline described as follows:

Beginning at Centerline Station 179+28.94 of the Crater Lake Parkway, Oregon Department of Transportation drawing 6B-10-6, thence leaving said Centerline North 40° 34' 38" East a distance of 93.31' to a point; thence 76.89' along a 55' radius curve to the left, (the long chord of which bears North 00°31'40" East, 70.78') to a point; thence North 39° 31' 18" West a distance of 153.96' to a point, thence 214.81' along a 381.09' radius curve to the right, (the long chord of which bears North 23°22'24" West, 211.98') to a point at the intersection of the Crater Lake Parkway right of way line and the beginning of right of way dedication; thence continuing along said curve 18.19', (the long chord of which bears North 05°51'28" West, 18.18') to a point; thence North 4° 29' 26" West a distance of 899.81 to a point; thence 151.82' along a 131.85' radius curve to the left. (the long chord of which bears North 37°28'38" West, 143,57') to a point: thence North 70° 27' 51" West a distance of 222.47' to a point, thence 108.60' along a 274.16' radius curve to the left, (the long chord of which bears North 81°48'43" West, 107.89') to a point; thence South 86° 50' 25" West a distance of 179.66' to a point; thence 333.47' along a 150.00' radius curve to the right, (the long chord of which bears North 29°28'19" West, 268.92') to a point; thence North 34° 12' 57" East a distance of 47.28' to a point; thence 257.48' along a 300.00' radius curve to the left, (the long chord of which bears North 09°37'41" East, 249.65') to a point; thence North 14° 57' 36" West a distance of 272.62' to a point; thence 103.67' along a 200.00' radius curve to the right, (the long chord of which bears North 00°06'36" West, 102.52') to a point; thence North 14° 44' 25" East a distance of 18.58' to a point at the intersection of Foothills Blvd right of way being the ending of right of way dedication, thence following said line 50.02' more or less to the centerline of Foothills Boulevard. 

REPORT GIVEN BY: MARK WILLRETT - PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR

ISSUE BEFORE COUNCIL: Should the City work with the County to have Vandenberg Road dedicated as public right-of-way under County Jurisdiction within City limits?

### SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND:

Vandenberg Road is the primary access road to the Jail and ties in Crater Lake Parkway and Foothills Blvd. While this road is within the City limits, it is not in a dedicated right-of-way, functioning more like a long private driveway. The County is looking to rectify this by formally dedicating the road for public access and utilities. As noted in the attached letter, normally when the City accepts infrastructure it is brought up to our standards. In this case that would be cost prohibitive and the County is willing to continue maintenance of this City road. A good example of this process is Foothills Blvd. While the road is exclusively within the City, it is maintained by the County.

### COUNCIL OPTION(S):

- 1. Authorize the City Manager to sign the County Order that will allow Vandenberg Road to become County right-of-way.
- 2. Do not authorize the City Manager to sign the Order and recommend that this road be under the jurisdiction of the City

### FINANCIAL IMPACT(S):

- 1. There are no financial impacts if the road becomes dedicated County jurisdiction.
- 2. If the City retains jurisdiction, it will be responsible for all future maintenance.

STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION: Council to approve Option 1.
