## - TRUSTEE'S DEED -

THIS INDENTURE, Dated April 4, 2024, between Andrew C. Brandsness, hereinafter called trustee, and Steven L. Ericson, Trustee of the Steven L. Ericson Separate Property Trust, hereinafter called the second party;

## WITNESSETH:

RECITALS: Robert H. Schock, as grantor, executed and delivered to Darrin W. Mercier, as trustee, for the benefit of Steven L. Ericson, Trustee of the Steven L. Ericson Separate Property Trust, as beneficiary, a certain trust deed dated May 15, 2022, duly recorded on August 1, 2022, in the mortgage records of Klamath County, Oregon, in book/reel/volume No. 2022, at page 009382. In that trust deed the real property therein and hereinafter described was conveyed by the grantor to the trustee to secure, among other things, the performance of certain obligations of the grantor to the beneficiary. The grantor thereafter defaulted in performance of the obligations secured by said trust deed as stated in the notice of default hereinafter mentioned and such default still existed at the time of the sale hereinafter described.

By reason of said default, the owner and holder of the obligations secured by said trust deed, being the beneficiary therein named, or his successor in interest, declared all sums so secured immediately due and owing. A notice of default containing an election to sell the real property and to foreclose the trust deed by advertisement and sale to satisfy the grantor's obligations was recorded on September 15, 2023, in the Records of Klamath County, in Volume 2023, Page 008062, to which reference now is made.

After the recording of notice of default, the undersigned trustee gave notice of the time for and place of sale of said real property as fixed by the trustee and as required by law. Copies of the Notice of Sale were served pursuant to ORCP 7D(2) and 7D(3) or mailed by both first class and certified mail with return receipt requested, to the last known addresses of the persons or their legal representatives, if any, named in ORS 86.764(1) and 86.764(2)(a), at least 120 days before the date the property was sold. A copy of the notice of sale was mailed by first class and certified mail with return receipt requested to the last known address of the fiduciary or personal representative of any person named in ORS 86.764(1), promptly after the trustee received knowledge of the of the disability, insanity or death of any such person. Copies of the notice of sale were served in accordance with ORS 86.774(1) upon occupants of the property described in the trust deed at least 120 days before the date the property was sold. If the foreclosure proceedings were stayed and released from the stay, copies of an amended notice of sale in the form required by ORS 86.782(6) were mailed by registered or certified mail to the last known address of those persons listed in ORS 86.764 and 86.774(1) and to the address provided by each person who was present at the time and place set for the sale which was stayed within 30 days after the release from the stay. The trustee published a copy of the notice of sale in a newspaper of general circulation in each county in which the said real property is situated, once a week for four successive weeks. The last publication of the notice occurred more than twenty days prior to the date of sale. The mailing, service and publication of the notice of sale are shown by affidavits and/or proofs of service duly recorded prior to the date of sale in the county records, those affidavits and proofs, together with the Notice of Default and Election to Sell and the notice of sale, being now referred to and incorporated in and made a part of this deed as if fully set forth herein. The undersigned trustee has no actual notice of any person, other than the persons named in those affidavits and proofs as having or claiming a lien on or interest in the real property, entitled to notice pursuant to ORS 86.764(1)(b) or (1)(c).

The true and actual consideration for this conveyance is \$166,900.00

The undersigned trustee, on April 4, 2024, at the hour of 11:00 a.m., in accord with the standard of time established by ORS 187.110 (which was the day and hour to which said sale was postponed as permitted by ORS 86.782(2)), and at the place so fixed for sale, in full accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon and pursuant to the powers conferred upon the trustee by said trust deed, sold the real property in one parcel at public auction to the second party for

the sum of \$166,960.89, the second party being the highest and best bidder at the sale, and that sum being the highest and best sum bid for the property.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the said sum so paid by the second party in cash, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and by the authority vested in said trustee by the laws of the state of Oregon and by said trust deed, the trustee does hereby convey unto the second party all interest which the grantor had or had the power to convey at the time of grantor's execution of the trust deed, together with any interest the grantor or his successors in interest acquired after the execution of said trust deed in and to the following described real property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the Westerly line of the Old Road leading from Klamath Falls to Keno, Oregon at the intersection of said line of road and the Northerly right-of-way line on the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company's logging road as same is now constructed; thence Northeasterly along the West line of said Old Road 306.50 feet to the point of beginning of the land herein conveyed; thence North 67°50' West at right angles to said County road 296.45 feet; thence North 22°10' East 141 feet; thence South 67°60' East 333.45 feet to the Westerly line of said County Road; thence Southwesterly along said line of road to the point of beginning, in the NE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 31, Township 39 South, Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian.

Beginning at a point on the Westerly line of Old Klamath Falls-Keno County Road which is North 22°10′ East a distance of 153.25 feet from the intersection of the Westerly line of said road with the Northerly right of way line of the Weyerhaeuser Timber Company's logging railroad; thence North 22°10′ East along the Westerly line of said road a distance of 153.25 feet; thence North 67°50′ West 148.25 feet; thence South 22°10′ West 153.25 feet; thence South 67°50′ East 148.25 feet to the point of beginning, in the NE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 31, Township 39 Sount, Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the second party and the second party's successors in interest and assigns forever.

In construing this instrument and whenever the context so requires, the singular includes the plural; "grantor" includes any successor in interest to the grantor, as well as each and every other persons owing an obligation, the performance of which is secured by the trust deed; "trustee" includes any successor trustee; "beneficiary" includes any successor in interest of the beneficiary first named above, and "person" includes a corporation and any other legal or commercial entity.
