RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

For value received, *Weston W. Walker* ("Grantor"), hereby grants to PacifiCorp, an Oregon corporation, its successors and assigns, ("Grantee"), a perpetual easement for a right of way **10** feet in width and **450** feet in length, more or less, for the construction, reconstruction, operation, maintenance, repair, replacement, enlargement, and removal of Grantee's electric power transmission, distribution and communication lines and all necessary or desirable accessories and appurtenances thereto, including without limitation: supporting towers, poles, props, guys and anchors, including guys and anchors outside of the right of way; wires, fibers, cables and other conductors and conduits therefor; and pads, transformers, switches, vaults and cabinets, along the general course now located by Grantee on, over, across or under the surface of the real property of Grantor in *Klamath* County, State of *OR*, more particularly described as follows and/or shown on Exhibit(s) *A* attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof:

A portion of:

The W1/2 SW1/4 and that portion of the SE1/4 SW1/4 lying South and West of the Southerly right-of-way line of the Main Ditch of the United States Reclamation Service, all in Section 6, Township 41 South, Range 11 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM that portion lying with the right of way of the Great Northern Railroad, the Klamath Falls Malin Highway; and also excepting therefrom the Easterly 33 feet thereof, reserved in Deed recorded April 16, 1910 in Volume 29, page 39, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon.

Together with the right of ingress and egress, for Grantee, its contractors, or agents, to the right of way from adjacent lands of Grantor for all activities in connection with the purposes for which this easement has been granted; and together with the present and (without payment therefor) the future right to keep the right of way and adjacent lands clear of all brush, trees, timber, structures, buildings and other hazards which might endanger Grantee's facilities or impede Grantee's activities.

At no time shall Grantor place, use or permit any equipment, material or vegetation of any kind that exceeds twelve (12) feet in height, light any fires, place or store any flammable materials, on or within the boundaries of the right of way. Subject to the foregoing limitations, the surface of the right of way may be used for other purposes not inconsistent, as defined by the Grantee, with the purposes for which this easement has been granted.

JURY WAIVER. TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, EACH OF THE PARTIES HERETO WAIVES ANY RIGHT IT MAY HAVE TO A TRIAL BY JURY IN RESPECT OF LITIGATION DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY ARISING OUT OF, UNDER OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS EASEMENT. EACH PARTY FURTHER WAIVES ANY RIGHT TO CONSOLIDATE, OR TO REQUEST THE CONSOLIDATION OF, ANY ACTION IN WHICH A JURY TRIAL HAS BEEN WAIVED WITH ANY OTHER ACTION IN WHICH A JURY TRIAL CANNOT BE OR HAS NOT BEEN WAIVED. THIS PARAGRAPH WILL SURVIVE THE EXPIRATION OR TERMINATION OF THIS AGREEMENT.

Grantor represents and warrants that it possesses all right, title and interest in and to the right of way area, free and clear of any lien, security interest, encumbrance, claim, license or other restriction that would interfere with Grantee's use of the right of way area for the purposes contemplated hereunder.

The rights and obligations of the parties hereto shall be binding upon and shall benefit their respective heirs, successors and assigns and shall run with the land.
